Global Classrooms for Peace

REQUIREMENTS

1. An Undergraduate degree from an accredited college or university
2. THREE years paid classroom experience at an accredited school
3. Currently employed at an accredited educational institution
4. Letter of agreement from educational institution with an intent to join Think.com
5. 3 Professional letters of reference including current principal or school administrator
6. 3 Personal letters of reference including a parent of a student, past or present
7. Essay, including a personal biography, interests, personal and professional thoughts on participation in the Global Classrooms for Peace program, as well as your proposed contribution to the program
8. Physical Condition. All teachers must be physically competent. Swimming, climbing, uphill hiking may be a part of the program. The schools are not always accessible by vehicle or boat; kayaks may be used in some instances. The Executive Director will have final sign off on whether a person is deemed physically able to participate.

IF YOU ARE SELECTED, THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS APPLY:

1. Participation in classroom lessons following the Global Classrooms for Peace curriculum in your current classroom
2. Create materials based on lessons provided by Global Classrooms for Peace to share with target classrooms at destination location (eg. Student created books)
3. Become a Think.com school
4. Commit to a continued relationship with the destination classroom via Think.com
5. Provide a current copy of a US Passport and plan for a current fingerprint report
6. Provide pictures of you teaching the lessons in your current classroom as well as teaching in the destination classrooms

Once selected, you will gain access to the lesson plans and travel preparation materials.

SELECTION PROCESS

1. Submit application
2. Initial phone interview by a Director of Global Classrooms for Peace
3. Second interview (phone or personal) with a member of the Recruitment Committee, Executive Committee and/or Executive Director
4. Reference check
5. Final vote by Recruitment Committee
